

Provider Access Statement

This statement sets out Bredon Hill Academy's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997. Pupil entitlement. All pupils in years 8 are entitled:
